Day care

An accredited day-care center welcomes nearly 100 children a day, and Head Start programs give low-income children a good start on their education.

Neighborhood services

A food pantry, a thrift shop and a Christmas Gift Shop help the community meet its needs. Social workers offer individual and family counseling.

Employment training

Youth and adults can train for jobs and take advantage of counseling and job placement services.

Summer and after-school programs

Kingdom House holds after-school activities and gives camp scholarships.

Kingdom House Family Center

The Family Center provides respite childcare and support services for parents under stress.

Youth and senior services

Youth leaders provide personal attention to at-risk youth, and youth leadership opportunities. Seniors are served by volunteers and the home health-care center.
